Our DDA compliant stair nosings are designed to improve step-edge visibility and meet best practice guidelines under the Equality Act (formerly the DDA) and Approved Document M (ADM) of UK Building Regulations.

Fully Compliant with UK Accessibility Standards

- 55mm Colour Bands: Contrasting inserts on both tread and riser improve visibility for all users, including the visually impaired.
- Meets Part M & BS8300: Designed in line with UK access regulations for public buildings, transport hubs, schools, and more.
- Guidance-Based Design: Ensures edge definition and visual contrast as outlined by BRE and government-approved accessibility documents.

Light Reflective Value (LRV) Compliance

To meet DDA requirements, the stair nosing must differ in LRV from the surrounding flooring by at least 30 points. This contrast ensures step edges are clearly visible and safe for all users.

When choosing your nosing, consider both the tread material and floor finish to ensure sufficient contrast.
